

Will there be live, public, indoor performances?

At this time, the school district is preparing to have in-person performances following the school district's current masking guidelines. This has the potential to change. Directors will prepare for virtual or recorded concerts in the event that in-person performances are restricted.

Are live, outdoor concerts or performances with in-person audiences permitted?

Yes. This has the potential to change.

Are special face coverings and physical distancing guidelines required for indoor music production?

Per school district policy, appropriate face coverings are required for indoor activities.

Singing: Face coverings are required while singing and speaking.

Wind instruments: Instrumentalists may remove face coverings inside while playing only. Bell covers or flute masks, provided by the school district, are to be used indoors for instrumentalists. Face coverings are required while speaking.

Percussionists and string players: Face coverings are required while playing and speaking. Indoor rehearsal time should be limited, and students should be distanced to a minimum of 3 feet.

If music production is taking place outside, are bell covers and masks required?

No, but students should be distanced to the extent possible.
