PSSA— Pennsylvania System of School Assessment

- Grades 3-8 English Language Arts and Mathematics
- Grades 4 and 8 Science

"The annual Pennsylvania System School Assessment is a standards-based, criterion-referenced assessment which provides students, parents, educators and citizens with an understanding of student and school performance related to the attainment of proficiency of the academic standards. These standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science and Technology identify what a student should know and be able to do at varying grade levels. School districts possess the freedom to design curriculum and instruction to ensure that students meet or exceed the standards' expectations." Source: PDE

Keystone Exams

- Algebra, Biology, Literature Exams
- Completed by Grades 9-11 (7-11 for Algebra) but reported in 11th Grade

"The Keystone Exams are end-of-course assessments designed to assess proficiency in the subject areas of Algebra I, Biology, and Literature. The Keystone Exams are one component of Pennsylvania's new system of high school graduation requirements. Keystone Exams will help school districts guide students toward meeting state standards." 5-Year Longitudinal Analysis - PSSA

 The PSSA was first aligned with the Pennsylvania Common Core Standards for the 2014-2015 school year.

• The alignment resulted in significant decreases in student achievement across the state.

 Fox Chapel has made consistent incremental achievement gains since the newly aligned assessments.



5-Year Longitudinal Analysis - PSSA


Key data points to review include:

- The increase in students who demonstrate grade level skills at the Advanced level.




5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 3 English Language Arts






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 3 Mathematics






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 4 English Language Arts






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 4 Mathematics






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis - Grade 4 Science






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 5 English Language Arts






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis - Grade 5 Mathematics






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis - Grade 6 English Language Arts






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 6 Mathematics






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 7 English Language Arts






5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 7 Mathematics








5-Year Longitudinal Analysis – Grade 8 Mathematics




